Financial results

On September 29, 2025, the periodic report of Genomtec SA for the period from January to the end of June (first half of 2025) was published.

New patents

On September 25, 2025, Genomtec received patent protection from the European Patent Office for the invention entitled: "Set of primers, composition of reagents and method for detecting atypical bacteria".

The development of a primer set is a key element of Genomtec's LAMP-based diagnostic method. Primers initiate the amplification reaction by recognizing a characteristic fragment of the pathogen's genome. Importantly, the number of primer sets that can be designed for a given pathogen using the LAMP technique is typically extremely limited. Such patent applications protect against the risk of competitors using the same primer set and limit their ability to develop equally rapid, sensitive, and specific diagnostic tests.

On September 15, 2025, the Company received notification that the Japanese Patent Office had granted it a patent for an invention for detecting HPV16 and HPV18 viruses. Protection is valid until 2040. This is the third patent granted to the Company in Japan.

In total, Genomtec has already been granted 16 patents worldwide, and over 30 more applications are pending.
